

RIIWH204D WORK SAFELY AT HEIGHTS

Duration: Full course: 2 days

Who Should Attend?

This course is applicable to Managers, Supervisors with responsibility for workers working at heights. It is most appropriate for workers working in operational roles where they are required to perform work at heights.

Purpose:

This purpose of this course is to provide information about the correct methods for checking, using, maintaining, cleaning and storing of personal fall prevention equipment.

Prerequisite:

There are no restrictions on entry to this course however, participants are required to have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instructions for safety at a workplace.

PARTICIPANTS MUST wear trousers, long sleeved shirts and enclosed footwear. Hard hats and gloves will be supplied.

Course Outcomes:

At the conclusion of this course, participants will competently demonstrate

- Selection of the most suitable type of fall prevention equipment
- How to perform an inspection on fall prevention equipment prior to using
- Determine when a piece of equipment should not be used and what to do about it
- How to select a suitable anchorage point and how to safely use it
- How to clean and store fall prevention equipment
- Be aware of Legislation, Australian standards and Codes of Practice that exist in regard to working at heights and fall prevention equipment

Assessment and Award:

Participants who demonstrate competency by passing both the theory and practical assessments will receive a 'Statement of Attainment' for the unit **RIIWH204D Work Safely at Heights**.
