Duration: Full course: 3 days

Refresher course: 1 day - A certified copy of student's "Statement of Attainment" - Work Safely in Confined Spaces with the above listed units must be supplied (acceptable currency three years).

Who Should Attend?

State legislation requires that all persons with work activities related to confined space/s must ensure suitable and adequate training, information and instruction to perform those activities. The relevant course should be chosen dependent on the required outcome. Supervisors and others responsible for confined space work should attend the Authorised Person course as a minimum and those who will work in confined spaces or assist those who work in confined spaces should attend the course Work Safely in a Confined Space.

Purpose and course outcomes:

This nationally recognised training course is designed for people who work in or around confined spaces. The course can be tailored to suit your company's specific training requirements focusing on the safety procedures and practical scenarios relevant to your particular confined space operations. While there is a standard set of learning outcomes for the course, we understand that the context and environment in which the learning is applied is varied. It is designed to teach participants how to:

- Identify and control confined space hazards
- Work safely within confined spaces
- Complete relevant risk assessments and permits
- Issue entry permits for confined space operations
- Operate various confined space safety equipment to allow for vertical or horizontal entries
- Understand the effects of airborne hazards on the body
- Use a gas detector and interpret readings
- Discharge the obligations of a standby person and supervise confined space operations
- Operate Breathing Apparatus
