

BSB60619 ADVANCED DIPLOMA OF WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY

Duration: Face to Face contact time - 5 days initial interactive class-based workshop, 12 – 24 months post course research projects to be conducted at the workplace.

Distance learning- 12 – 24 months, workplace-based post course research projects to be either conducted at the workplace or via completion of case studies.

Recognition of Prior Learning available – discuss with your trainer the RPL option (for blended delivery or full completion).

Participants will need access to a workplace and appropriate level of information and monitoring equipment to enable completion of learning and assessment activities.

Participants are expected to be currently or recently employed in WHS management or leadership roles.

Who Should Attend:

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who apply advanced practical knowledge and skills to coordinate, facilitate and maintain a Work Health Safety (WHS) program. It is suited to those who possess significant work health and safety skills and knowledge; and wish to consolidate and build pathways to further educational and/or employment opportunities.

Pathways into the Qualification:

Entry Requirements: All core units in BSB51319 Diploma of Work Health and Safety or equivalent competencies:

BSBWHS513 – Lead WHS risk management

BSBWHS515 – Lead initial response and investigate WHS incidents

BSBWHS516 – Contribute to developing, implementing and maintaining an organisations WHS management system.

BSBWHS519 – Lead the development and use of WHS risk management tools

BSBWHS522 – Manage WHS consultation and participation processes

A certified copy of your BSB51319 Diploma of Work Health and Safety transcript must be supplied.

BSBWHS613 – Evaluate the WHS performance of an organisation

BSBWHS614 – Conduct a WHS audit under the guidance of a lead auditor

BSBWHS617 – Apply ergonomics to manage WHS risks

Assessment and Award:

Participants who demonstrate competency by passing all of the theory and practical assessments will receive a 'Qualification' in '**BSB60619 Advanced Diploma of Work Health and Safety**' issued by Simpatico Safety Training and Consultancy. Participants who complete individual units will receive a 'Statement of Attainment' for those units completed.

Participants must complete this course within 24 months of course commencement.
