

BSB41419 CERTIFICATE IV WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY

Duration:

Face to Face contact time – pre-course assessment, 5 days initial interactive class-based workshop, 6-12 months given for post course assignment.

Distance/Online – self-paced assignments to be completed over 12-month duration, resource access and support available.

Recognition of Prior Learning available – discuss with your trainer the RPL option (for blended delivery or full completion).

Who Should Attend?

This qualification is suitable for people working in a work health and safety (WHS) role, who provide a broad range of technical knowledge and skills and have some limited responsibility for the output of others. This qualification applies to those working as supervisors, WHS personnel and workers in other WHS related roles who manage risks effectively, apply relevant WHS laws and contribute to WHS within the workplace in known or changing contexts with established parameters.

Entry Requirements:

There are no restrictions on entry to this course however participants are required to have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instruction for:

- Referencing and understanding legislation, standards and codes of practice
- Consulting with workers and employers on safety issues
- Preparing workplace health and safety reports

Pathways into the qualification:

Candidates may enter the qualification through a number of entry points including: BSB30715 Certificate III in Work Health and Safety or other relevant Certificate III qualification or with vocational experience in work health and safety roles.

Examples of indicative job roles for candidates seeking entry based upon their vocational experience include:

- Health and Safety Representative
- Health and Safety Committee Member
- Health and Safety Assistant.

This breadth of expertise would equate to the competencies required to undertake this qualification.

Pathways from the qualification:

After achieving this qualification candidates may undertake: BSB51319 - Diploma of Work Health and Safety.

Assessment and Award:

Participants who demonstrate competency by passing all of the theory and practical assessments will receive a 'Qualification' in '**BSB41419 Certificate IV Work Health and Safety**' issued by Simpatico Safety Training and Consultancy. Participants who complete individual units will receive a 'Statement of Attainment' for those units completed.
Participants must complete this course within 12 months of course commencement.

Certificate IV Assessment Support:
