

## HLTAID009 PROVIDE CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION

**Duration:** 3 hours

## Who Should Attend:

This unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. Specific licensing/regulatory requirements relating to this competency, including requirements for refresher training should be obtained from the relevant national/state/territory Work Health and Safety Regulatory Authorities.

## **Course Outcomes:**

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

The skills and knowledge described here relate specifically to performing Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and do **NOT** address other aspects of resuscitation, life support or first aid.

## **Performance Criteria:**

Recognise and assess an emergency situation.

Ensure safety for self, bystanders and casualty.

Assess the casualty and recognise the need for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

Seek assistance from emergency services.

Perform CPR in accordance with the ARC guidelines.

Display respectful behaviour towards casualty.

Operate an automated external defibrillator (AED) according to manufacturers' instructions.

Accurately convey incident details to emergency services.

Report details of incident in line with appropriate workplace or site procedures.

Maintain privacy and confidentiality of information in line with statutory or organisational policies. Recognise the possible psychological impacts on self and other rescuers and seek help when required. Contribute to a review of the first aid response as required.

**Award:** Participants who demonstrate competency in both the theory and practical assessments will receive a <u>Statement of Attainment</u> - HLTFAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation' issued by Simpatico Safety Training and Consultancy that is valid for 1 year. This course relates to the HLT Health Training package

Please note that to demonstrate competency in the practical component of CPR you must be able to conduct two minutes of uninterrupted CPR on the floor (following training package guidance).
