

UETDRRF004 PERFORM RESCUE FROM A LIVE LV PANEL (COMMON UNIT GROUP: HLTAID009 PROVIDE CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION)

Duration: 5 hours

Who Should Attend:

This course is aimed at people in the electrical industry who wish to gain low voltage switchboard rescue and resuscitation skills for their workplace or personal benefit. This course meets the requirements of the Electrical Safety Act and the Code of Practice: Electrical Work, Part 4 – Working Live.

Course Outcomes:

This competency unit covers the performance of rescue procedures from live Low Voltage (LV) apparatus (not incl. overhead lines and underground cables in the workplace). It specifies the mandatory requirements of rescue from a live LV panel and how they apply in the transmission, distribution or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for health, safety and risk management processes at all operational levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.

Competency Units:

UETDRRF004 Perform rescue from a live LV panel

Please note: Granting of competency in this unit shall be made only after competency in the unit HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation has been confirmed.

Course outcomes include:

- Instruction in hazards and risk control measure for specific work functions and work areas are identified and obtained.
- Electricity isolation point is identified and labelled where appropriate
- Tools and emergency equipment are checked for safety, functionality and placed in an accessible location to facilitate response and rescue according to established procedures
- Workplace procedures and instructions for controlling risk are followed
- Workplace procedures for assessing and isolating the LV panel and removing the victim, where necessary, from contact with live apparatus are followed
- Workplace procedures for applying CPR if required at the site and gaining access to treatment by a medical professional if necessary are followed
- The worksite is secured and entry controlled until appropriate authorities inspect and release the site
- Processes for reporting accidents and or incidents to authorised personnel are confirmed in accordance with established procedures

Award: Participants who demonstrate competency in both the theory and practical assessments will receive a <u>Statement of Attainment</u> for UETDRRF004 –Perform rescue from a live LV panel issued by Simpatico Safety Training.
